The Children's Arts Covid-19 Fund

We will be awarding two grants of £500 to children's arts organisations who have been adversely affected by Covid-19.

Eligibility – to apply for this funding, your organisation must either:

* have a three year demonstrable track-record of working predominantly in children's arts *OR*

* if your organisation was founded in the last three years, its creative output must solely be aimed at children.

Your organisation must also meet the following requirements:

* annual turnover of <£75,000

* be a registered charity, Community Interest Company or Company Limited by Guarantee

* be ineligible for ACE funding and the government furlough scheme

We will expect all organisations applying to demonstrate that our £500 could make a **noticeable** difference to the survival of their organisation.

How to apply – please write no more than 500 words, using the following headings:

1. Work for children and young people – tell us about the work that you have created for children and young people over the last three years. We are particularly interested in work for children aged 13 and under.

2. Finances – how has your organisation been impacted by Covid-19? What costs would a £500 grant from ACA enable you to cover, and how would the grant ensure the survival of your organisation?

3. Other support – please explain why you are ineligible for government support, the furlough scheme, and ACE funding.

Please also remember to include your charity/company number, along with proof of your annual turnover.
