- 1. Give students access to age-appropriate LGBTQ+ role models.
- 2. If a young person comes out to you while you are working with them, their disclosure is not a safeguarding issue unless you consider them to be at risk of verbal abuse from classmates / family members.
- 3. Always welcome people by asking them to share their pronouns.
- 4. Use the correct pronouns when talking about people, as well as when talking to them.
- 5. Consider using temporary signage if gender neutral toilets are not available in your working space.
- 6. Try and use gender neutral language when addressing groups. Rather than 'boys and girls', try saying 'folks'.
- 7. Schools should include parents in their plans for Sex and Relationship education.
- 8. Young people are creating new language around gender. It is important to listen.
- 9. Don't shut down conversations that scare you!
